Doctoral program at the transregional Research Training Group “Statistical Modeling in Psychology” (SMiP) at the University of Kobenz-Landau (Campus Landau)

The Research Training Group “Statistical Modeling in Psychology” (SMiP) offers a three-year doctoral program in Psychology, funded by the German Research Foundation (Deutsche Forschungsgemeinschaft, DFG). The Research Training Group SMiP is a transregional collaboration of twelve renowned behavioral researchers from five German universities: University of Mannheim, Albert-Ludwigs-University Freiburg, Ruprecht-Karls-University Heidelberg, University of Koblenz-Landau at Landau, and Eberhard Karls University Tübingen. At the Department of Psychology in Landau, Benjamin E. Hilbig and Tanja Lischetzke are involved in SMiP as Principal Investigators.

Ph.D. students will develop their precise dissertation projects jointly with their advisor within the first months of doctoral studies. Roughly speaking, these Ph.D. projects can be assigned to three thematic areas: modeling cognition and social cognition, modeling motivation and affect, and modeling individual differences. Within each thematic area, two complementary and intertwined approaches are possible: projects focusing primarily on model developments and statistical refinements (model development perspective) and projects aiming at innovative applications of existing models to new research questions (model application perspective).
